**Amendment No. 2**

*(This amendment restores one-time, non-recurring appropriations in certain categories of the Board of Education Budget for Fiscal Year 2020 with the desire that the appropriations should be used to provide for Transportation costs, Enrollment Growth, and the Health Fund, which do not count towards maintenance of effort.)*

1 On page 1, in line 3, strike “\$605,200,000” and substitute “\$612,500,000”.

3 In the “Instruction” row in the major categories table attached to the Resolution, strike  
4 “374,083,851” and substitute “376,183,851”.

6 In the “Student Health Services” row in the major categories table attached to the Resolution,  
7 strike “9,336,918” and substitute “13,336,918”.

9 In the “Student Transportation” row in the major categories table attached to the Resolution,  
10 strike “41,292,289” and substitute “42,492,289”.

12 Correspondingly correct the “General Fund Budget” subtotal and the “Total General Fund,  
13 Restricted Funds and Other Expense Budget” total.

15 This Amendment is contingent on the adoption of Amendment 3 to Council Bill 24-2019.
