

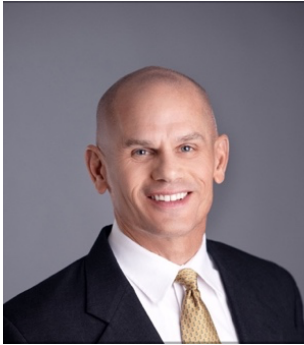

Omar Jones is a retired Army Lieutenant General with 30+ years of experience leading, building, and coaching inspired teams to achieve enduring results.

He currently leads Omar Jones Consulting & Advisory where he assists executive leaders optimize talent management, leader development, and organizational performance with a primary focus on entities supporting military installations.

Omar has significant experience building coalitions between governmental and private organizations and among local, state, and federal governmental organizations.

As Commanding General of the U.S. Army Installation Command, he led a global organization managing over 100 installations, 60,000 teammates, and a \$14 billion budget, focusing on innovation and stakeholder engagement while supporting readiness across the Army and quality of life for soldiers and their families.

Throughout his career, Omar built coalitions between governmental and private organizations, and across local, state, and federal levels. He led the Department of Defense's Joint Task Force – National Capital Region, overseeing the DoD's response in the region to the COVID-19 pandemic and military support for the 2021 Presidential Inauguration. Earlier, as Chief of Public Affairs for the U.S. Army, he planned and executed Army-wide communication strategies and developed strong relationships with media, academia, and government officials.

He was a career infantry officer who led Soldiers from platoon to General Officer command. Omar has operational experience across the US, Germany, Bulgaria, and Bosnia with combat experience in Iraq, Afghanistan, and Kuwait.

Omar is currently the Advisory Board Chair for GreenGen in Bethesda, Maryland. He is also a senior advisor and board member for the Military Housing Association. And, he is a member of the President's Advisory Council for the Association of Defense Communities.

Omar holds a Master of Public Administration from Harvard University's John F. Kennedy School of Government, a Master of National Security Strategy from the National Defense University's National War College, and a Bachelor of Science in Operations Research from the United States Military Academy at West Point, New York.
