1 **Section 1. Be It Enacted** by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that the Howard  
2 County Code is amended as follows:

10 **Section 15.518. Agricultural Land Preservation Board.**

11 (h) *Duties and Responsibilities.* The Board shall:

- 12 (1) Make recommendations to the County Executive on the acquisition of  
13 AGRICULTURAL LAND PRESERVATION easements as provided in this subtitle[.];
- 14 [(2) Review proposals for the location of permitted lots and the construction of tenant  
15 housing on land subject to an agricultural land preservation easement.
- 16 (3) Review proposals for proposed subdivisions on land subject to an agricultural  
17 land preservation easement.]]
- 18 (2) RECOMMEND TO THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE AND THE COUNTY COUNCIL THE  
19 CRITERIA AND METHOD FOR CALCULATING THE PRICE FOR PURCHASE OF AN  
20 AGRICULTURAL LAND PRESERVATION EASEMENT;
- 21 (3) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS OF THE DEED OF EASEMENT AND THIS SUBTITLE,  
22 REVIEW AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS ON:
- 23 (I) PROPOSALS FOR THE LOCATION OF PERMITTED LOTS AND DWELLINGS;  
24 (II) PROPOSALS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF TENANT HOUSING; AND  
25 (III) PROPOSALS FOR PARCEL SUBDIVISION OF THE LAND;
- 26 (4) REVIEW AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS ON AGRICULTURAL LAND PRESERVATION  
27 PROGRAM POLICY, AND AGRICULTURAL POLICY IN GENERAL;
- 28 (5) SERVE IN AN ADVISORY CAPACITY TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND ZONING  
29 ON AGRICULTURAL ISSUES, INCLUDING THE EVALUATION OF ZONING RELATED  
30 COMPLAINTS, BASED ON THE BOARD’S KNOWLEDGE OF COMMON AND ACCEPTABLE

1 FARMING PRACTICES; AND

2 [[(4) Make recommendations to the County Executive concerning its budget and  
3 appropriations requests.]]

4 ([[5]]6)Report annually on the status of the program to the County Executive and the  
5 County Council.

6 [[(6) Recommend to the County Executive and the County Council the criteria and  
7 method for calculating the price for purchase of an agricultural land preservation  
8 easement.

9 (7) Solicit donations of funds to be used in this program from all appropriate sources  
10 and to solicit donations of easement on land.]]

12 ***Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted*** by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland that  
13 *this Act shall become effective 61 days after its enactment.*
