Howard County has received an additional \$18,908 from the Baltimore City Department of Social Services (BCDSS) for the Work-on-Wheels (WoW) program. This represents an increase over the \$189,083 provided by BCDSS over the last five years.

The WoW program is a reverse commute van service connecting residents of Baltimore City to employment opportunities in Howard County. This project is managed through the Office of Transportation by the Ride Share coordinator.
