CHRISTOPHER I. WILLIAMS

Christopher Williams is currently assigned to the 94th Intelligence Squadron, Fort George G. Meade, Maryland. Additionally, he serves as a Deputy Ambassador for the Student Veterans of America, American Military University Chapter. Christopher is originally from Miccosukee, Florida and entered the Air Force in March 2011. In 2012, he graduated from the Pashto Cryptologic Language Basic Course at the Defense Language Institute, Monterey, California, and in February 2013 the Basic Cryptologic Linguist Course at Goodfellow Air Force Base, Texas. He currently holds an Associate's Degree in Pashto, and earned his second Associate's Degree from the Community College of the Air Force in Intelligence Studies. He is now pursuing his undergraduate degree in Environmental Science at American Military University, concentrating in sustainability. Christopher has been assigned to the 94th Intelligence Squadron since March 2013, and his military awards include the Air Force Commendation Medal, Military Outstanding Volunteer Service Medal, and German Armed Forces Proficiency Badge. He was also recognized with the Commandant's Award at Airman Leadership School, and named the Non-Commissioned Officer of the First Quarter for 2016 over 200 peers in his unit. Christopher is an avid volunteer with Special Olympics throughout the multiple states he has been stationed in and volunteers with the National Park Service. Along with this, Christopher has become involved with the Howard County Maryland, Veterans and Military Families Commission and recently been nominated for appointment to the commission as a member. Christopher is also active in the community with the Knights of Columbus fraternity, and the Patriot Guard Riders.
