6	Howard County to run for office on the strength of their ideas, supported by small
7 8	donations from ordinary people and matching funds from the Citizens' Election Fund;

25	shall be non-reverting. No appropriation for a capital project in the capital budget shall
26	lapse until the purpose for which the appropriation was made shall have been
27	accomplished or abandoned; provided, however, that any capital project shall stand
28	abandoned if three fiscal years elapse without any expenditure from or encumbrance of
29	the appropriation made therefor. The balances remaining to the credit of the completed or

26	FUNDED CAMPAIGN SYSTEM FOR CANDIDATES FOR COUNTY COUNCIL OR COUNTY
27	Executive, or both. The ordinance shall include, but not be limited to,

- (3) REQUIRE THE COMMISSION TO CALCULATE, NOT LATER THAN 180 DAYS PRIOR TO THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR, THE TOTAL AMOUNT ESTIMATED FOR THE FULL ELECTION CYCLE AND THE AMOUNT TO BE INCLUDED IN THE CURRENT EXPENSE BUDGET FOR THE ENSUING FISCAL YEAR TO FULLY FUND THE CITIZEN FUNDED CAMPAIGN SYSTEM.
- (B) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, IN EACH FISCAL YEAR THE EXECUTIVE SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE REQUIRED BY ARTICLE VI OF THIS CHARTER THE AMOUNT NECESSARY TO FULLY FUND THE CITIZEN FUNDED CAMPAIGN SYSTEM FOR THE ENSUING FISCAL YEAR, AS CALCULATED BY THE COMMISSION.
- (2) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF ARTICLE VI OF THIS CHARTER TO THE CONTRARY, IF THE EXECUTIVE DOES NOT INCLUDE THE AMOUNT REQUIRED BY PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE COUNTY COUNCIL MAY AMEND THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE REQUIRED BY ARTICLE VI TO INCLUDE THE REQUIRED AMOUNT.
- (C) THE EXECUTIVE IS NOT REQUIRED TO INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE THE AMOUNT REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (B) (1) OF THIS SECTION IF:
- (1) DURING THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR, FUNDS HAVE BEEN OR ARE BEING TRANSFERRED FROM THE BUDGET STABILIZATION ACCOUNT TO THE GENERAL FUND REVENUES IN THE CURRENT EXPENSE BUDGET PURSUANT TO SECTION 615A OF THIS CHARTER; OR
- (2) NOT LATER THAN 120 DAYS PRIOR TO THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR, THE EXECUTIVE CERTIFIES TO THE COUNCIL THAT THE COUNTY'S FISCAL CONDITION MAKES IT IMPRUDENT TO INCLUDE THE AMOUNT, AND THE COUNCIL APPROVES THE CERTIFICATION BY A VOTE OF NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF ITS MEMBERS.

amendment to the Howard County Charter shall be submitted to the voters of Howard
County for their adoption or rejection in accordance with the provisions of the Article X
of the Howard County Charter and Article XIA of the Maryland Constitution, and if
adopted by the majority of the voters, shall stand adopted from and after the 30^{th} day
following the general election;
AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard
County, Maryland, that the Citizen Funded Campaign System shall take effect for the
2022 election cycle;
AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard
County, Maryland, that this Resolution, having been approved by two-thirds of the
members of the Howard County Counc <mark>il,</mark> stands adopted this day of
, 2016 in accordance with Article X of the Howard County Charter.
