



The Administration is seeking Council approval for a bill amending Howard County Code in regards to the Howard County Retirement Plan.

The Office of Human Resources has proposed changes to the Howard County Code, Sec. 1.406 (o) *Definitions* regarding Corrections Employees.

In accordance with the negotiated contract with Local 3080, a new classification, Correctional Sergeant-Dietary was developed. This classification needs to be added to the list of position classifications that are included in the Corrections Retirement system.
