15	final phase to Waverly Elementary School where bids came in higher than anticipated; and

17	WHEREAS, the transfer will move \$1,700,000 in county bond funding to Capital
18	Project E-0973, Waverly Elem Renovation/Phase II Addition; and

20	WHEREAS, Section 609(b) of the Howard County Charter authorizes and empowers the
