7 additional acre (or fraction thereof) based on the LOD.”; and

* Consistent with Council Resolution No. 63-2017, Grading Plans for lots with 2.0 acres or less of disturbance will be charged a fee of \$250.00. Grading Plans for lots with disturbances greater than 2.0 acres will be charged \$250.00, plus \$20.00 per each additional acre (or fraction thereof) based on the LOD.

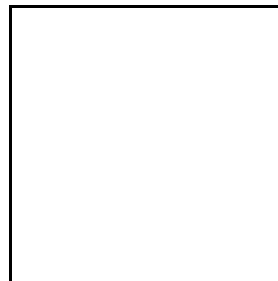
