17	Section 1. Be It Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland that, in
18	regard to the Agreement between Howard County and the American Federation of State,
19	County and Municipal Employees, Howard County Local 1810, Council 67, AFL-CIO, the
20	County Council approves the attached Conflicting Provisions, listed in Exhibit B as attached
21	to this Act and incorporated herein, that are in conflict with the provisions of Title 1 "Human
22	Resources" of the Howard County Code or the Employee Manual.

24	Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland
25	that the provisions of this Act shall apply beginning with the first pay date after May 1, 2012.
