8	WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations
9	upon the County, including the provision by the County of the local share of the project
10	costs in the program; and

12	WHEREAS, it is required by the United States Department of Transportation, in
13	accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 that, in
14	connection with the filing of an application for assistance under the Federal Transit Act,
15	the applicant give an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of
16	1964 and the United States Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; and

18	WHEREAS, the County's goal is that minority business enterprise to be utilized
19	to the fullest extent possible in connection with this project, and definite procedures shall
20	be established and administered to ensure that minority business shall have the maximum
21	construction contracts, supplies, equipment contracts or consultants and other services.

24	County, Maryland this 6th day of February, 2012 that the County's application
25	for a grant under the Federal Transit Act be endorsed.
