

Dear County Council members,

Thank you for your support of the County's Plan to End Homelessness. We know what works: the Coordinated System of Homeless Services' diversion, rapid rehousing, case management and housing vouchers. But the data show that we are not on a path to ending homelessness. More people enter the system each month than leave it. The waiting list, at 279 households this past August, shows that the system is under-resourced to meet the need for services.

As you consider the FY 2018 County budget, I urge you to keep in mind the PEH goal: END homelessness. To get to that goal will require additional CSHS resources. Let's do more of what's proven to work. I ask your commitment to approve a FY 2018 budget that includes more housing vouchers and additional case management and flexible financial assistance.

Let's not just continue to tread water; let's stem the tide of homelessness!
