

The Department of Technology & Communication Services has been designated coordinator for the preparation of testimony relative to the donation of a surplus mainframe computer to the Charles County Board of Education. The machine is an IBM z800 - Model 0E1, and is no longer needed for County purposes.

Section 4.129 of the Howard County Code authorizes the County Purchasing Agent, with the approval of the County Executive and the County Council, to sell surplus supplies to the State or any political subdivision for nominal consideration. In accordance with Section 4.129, the Charles County Public School System has agreed to purchase the surplus mainframe computer for \$10.
