Amendment No. 2

(This amendment restricts the location, size, sales, and trucks associated with natural wood waste recycling on certain farms if an MDE permit is not required.)

1 On page 2, in line 3, after “USE” insert “IF THE FARM ABUTS AN INTERSTATE HIGHWAY AND THE
2 AREA USED FOR THE NATURAL WOOD WASTE RECYCLING DOES NOT EXCEED 1 ACRE OR 5% OF THE
3 FARM, WHICHEVER IS LESS. THE PRODUCT OF THE RECYCLING MAY NOT BE SOLD AT WHOLESALE OR
4 RETAIL. THE RECYCLING ACTIVITY SHALL NOT INVOLVE ANY TRUCKS THAT EXCEED 10,000 POUNDS
5 GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT.”.

6 Also on page 2, in line 6, after “USE” insert “IF THE FARM ABUTS AN INTERSTATE HIGHWAY AND
7 THE AREA USED FOR THE NATURAL WOOD WASTE RECYCLING DOES NOT EXCEED 1 ACRE OR 5% OF
8 THE FARM, WHICHEVER IS LESS. THE PRODUCT OF THE RECYCLING MAY NOT BE SOLD AT WHOLESALE
9 OR RETAIL. THE RECYCLING ACTIVITY SHALL NOT INVOLVE ANY TRUCKS THAT EXCEED 10,000
10 POUNDS GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT.”.

11 Also on page 2, in line 9, after “USE” insert “IF THE FARM ABUTS AN INTERSTATE HIGHWAY AND
12 THE AREA USED FOR THE NATURAL WOOD WASTE RECYCLING DOES NOT EXCEED 1 ACRE OR 5% OF
13 THE FARM, WHICHEVER IS LESS. THE PRODUCT OF THE RECYCLING MAY NOT BE SOLD AT WHOLESALE
14 OR RETAIL. THE RECYCLING ACTIVITY SHALL NOT INVOLVE ANY TRUCKS THAT EXCEED 10,000
15 POUNDS GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT.”.
