**Amendment No. 13**

*(This amendment allows farmers with excess compost to sell the excess under specified conditions.)*

1 On page 17, insert at line 25: “IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPHS C. AND D. OF THIS SUBSECTION  
2 9, A FARMER WHO PRODUCES COMPOST IN EXCESS OF THE AMOUNT THAT MAY BE USED ON THE  
3 FARMER’S FARM IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE FARM MAY  
4 SELL THE EXCESS COMPOST, PROVIDED THERE IS NO OUTSTANDING INSTALLMENT PURCHASE  
5 AGREEMENT FOR AN AGRICULTURAL LAND PRESERVATION EASEMENT ON THE PROPERTY, OR, IF  
6 THERE IS SUCH AN INSTALLMENT PURCHASE AGREEMENT, SALES MAY NOT EXCEED 5% OF THE  
7 TOTAL YEARLY PRODUCTION, AS REPORTED TO THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF THE  
8 ENVIRONMENT (MDE).”.
