6	rules, regulations, and procedures for the administration of the program; and

8	WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works requires each local Board of Education to
9	submit, annually, to the Interagency Committee on School Construction an updated and detailed
10	Capital Budget Request for the upcoming fiscal year and a 5-year Capital Improvement Program
11	Request, both of which must have been approved by the appropriate local governing body; and

13	WHEREAS, the County Council of Howard County has received and considered a
14	report and recommendation from the Howard County Planning Board on the Board of
15	Education's Capital Budget Request for Fiscal Year 2019 and the Capital Improvement Program
16	Request for Fiscal Years 2020-2024.

19	Maryland this day of, 2017, that it approves the Board of Education's
20	Capital Budget Request for Fiscal Year 2019 and the Capital Improvement Program Request for

Dear Ms. Sager:

As you are aware, the request for state funding of school construction projects must be approved annually by the County Council pursuant to Section 5-301 of the Education Article, Annotated Code of Maryland. This approval must take place by November 27, 2017.

To facilitate this approval, we follow a process which includes the public input and approval by the Board of Education. For the County Council to take action, the Planning Board must review the proposal to ensure General Plan conformance. Per your correspondence with Jennifer Bubenko of my staff, we agree to the following schedule:

September 15

Draft budget pages provided to you.

September 19

Board of Education approval of Superintendent's Capital Budget.

September 20 (before noon)

Provide you with spreadsheet pages for the Board's Capital Budget with copies to Lonnie R. Robbins, Chief Administrative Officer.

September 20 (deadline 2:00pm)

Bill will be pre-filed with the County Council.

October 2 (7:00 p.m.)

Legislation is introduced at the County Council session.

October 16 (7:00 p.m.)

County Council holds public hearing on the legislation. (HCPSS representative must be present.)

October 23 (4:30 p.m.)

County Council holds public work session. (HCPSS representative must be present.)

November 6 (7:00 p.m.)

County Council votes on resolution.

We understand that County Council approval at this stage is only preliminary approval. The Council will act on the County Executive's Capital Budget request for the Board in May of 2018.
