1	WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 18.204 of the Howard County Code, Elm Street
2	Communities, Inc. ("petitioner") has petitioned the County Council of Howard County to close a
3	segment of road that was formerly part of U.S. Route 1 that is commonly known as "Deadman's
4	Curve", as described in Exhibit A and shown on the attached certified plat identified as Exhibit B
5	(the "Road"); and
6	WHEREAS, Section 18.204 of the Howard County Code provides for the closure of an
7	existing county road by the adoption of a County Council Resolution; and
8	WHEREAS, the maintenance obligations of the Road were transferred to Howard
9	County by the State Roads Commission on November 29, 1955; however, the State did not
10	deliver a deed to the Road and
11	WHEREAS, there are no homes and only 1 commercial structure along the Road; and
12	WHEREAS, the Departments of Public Works, Planning and Zoning, Police, and Fire
13	and Rescue have each reviewed the proposal to close of the Road and each has determined the
14	closure of the Road will not affect public safety, the traffic network, or public convenience; and
15	WHEREAS, the petitioner is the contract purchaser for all of the adjacent land, including
16	the commercial structure along the Road; and
17	WHEREAS, the petitioner has paid a fee in accordance with Section 18.204 to cover the
18	costs of advertising the proposed closing, notifying adjoining property owners, and posting the
19	Road; and
20	WHEREAS, notice of the proposed closing of the Road that was formerly part of U.S.
21	Route 1 that is commonly known as "Deadman's Curve" has been posted and advertised in
22	accordance with Section 18.204; and
23	WHEREAS, the petitioner, at its cost and expense, shall cause the closure of the Road,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland this <u>4</u>th day of <u>December</u>, 2017 that, in accordance with Section 18.204 of the Howard County Code, the closure of the segment of road that was formerly part of U.S. Route 1 that is commonly known as "Deadman's Curve" will not adversely affect public safety, the traffic network, or public convenience and the Road as shown and described in Exhibits A and B shall be closed.







Dear Ms. Bishop,

This letter is in response to the petition to the above referenced closing.

Our records indicate BGE has electric and/or gas facilities located within the area of the proposed closing. We do not currently have any agreements to a portion of these facilities. These facilities were installed under franchise rights and will, now, require an easement to be granted to BGE. Therefore, we object to the closings prior to, either, (A) the execution of a Right of Way Agreement that will allow BGE to continue to operate, maintain and have access to our existing facilities or (B) the petitioner requesting and receiving permission to relocate the existing facilities, at the petitioner's expense.

Please have the petitioner contact me regarding the aforementioned options. The petitioner will be directed to the impacted departments and will be provided additional information including related costs. Once BGE is able to reach an agreement with the petitioner, we may withdraw our objection to the petitioner's request.


As you may know, records are not always complete, or up to date, and that other BGE facilities may exist in the subject area. If BGE facilities are found in the subject area, it shall be the responsibility of the petitioner to provide an easement for access, operation and maintenance of said facilities. Furthermore, should any subsequent relocation of BGE facilities be necessary in order to utilize the closing area, the relocation costs will be the sole responsibility of the petitioner.

Petitioners are hereby informed that any proposed improvements in the vicinity of any existing BGE facilities, are subject to all federal, state, and local rules and regulations regarding applicable gas pipeline standards and electrical standards including the National Electric Safety Code (NESC). These standards should be closely reviewed in order to maintain adequate clearances from the existing BGE facilities. The NESC website is: http://standards.ieee.org/nesc/.







Please be advised that this office represents Elm Street Communities, Inc., the contract purchaser for the following parcels of land located in Elkridge, Howard County, Maryland: (i) Tax Map 38, Parcel 279; (ii) Tax Map 38, Parcel 352; and (iii) Tax Map 38, Parcel 847 (collectively, the "Properties"; See Tax Map Section attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u>).

Pursuant to Section 18.204 of the Howard County Code, please accept this letter on behalf of the Petitioner as a request to formally close the entirety of that former section of U.S. Route 1 (a/k/a County Route (CO) 277) running through the Properties and commonly known as "Deadman's Curve," all as referenced and specified in greater detail hereinafter.

In accordance with Section 18.204(d), the Petitioner submits herewith the following:

- (1) A detailed description of "Deadman's Curve" to be closed (**Exhibit B**); and
- (2) A certified plat signed and sealed by a professional land surveyor particularly describing the portion of Deadman's Curve" to be formally closed (**Exhibit C**).

The Petitioner, after consultation with the Howard County Office of Law and the Data Services Division of the Maryland State Highway Administration ("SHA"), presents the following ownership information regarding the ownership and easement rights related to the roadbed and right-of-way constituting the subject "Deadman's Curve" to be closed hereunder:

Through the passage of the Turnpike Act of 1812, Chapter 78, the Maryland General Assembly chartered the Washington and Baltimore Turnpike Company to construct and operate a turnpike road between the District of Columbia and the Baltimore City. The turnpike road constructed under the Act is now known as U.S. Route 1 (Maryland), with that portion running through Howard County, Maryland in the area of the Properties known locally as Washington Boulevard. The present-day location of the "Deadman's Curve" roadbed represents a portion of the original alignment of Washington Boulevard.

Through a series of Plats recorded by the State Roads Commission of Maryland ("SRC") in 1942 (Plat Nos. 5549 - 5551), all entitled "Balto & Wash Blv'd Relocation of Deadmans Curve So of Elkridge," "Deadman's Curve" was straightened out in connection with the realignment and expansion of Washington Boulevard into a four (4) lane road (See Exhibit D attached hereto). Upon the relocation of "Deadman's Curve," this section of Washington Boulevard was renamed MD 597. After construction of the new four (4) lane Washington Blvd, the SRC transferred maintenance of MD 597 and the stub section known as "Deadman's Curve" to Howard County, Maryland in December 1955 (See <u>Exhibits E</u> and <u>F</u> attached hereto). Upon the transfer, this portion of the roadbed was re-numbered County Route (CO) 277 When County Route (CO) 277 was re-inventoried in 1969 by the SHA, the "Deadman's Curve" section was found to have been in use by a construction company and when re-inventoried in 2001, SHA found it to have been barricaded about 0.12 mile into the roadway (See <u>Exhibits G</u> and <u>H</u> attached hereto). At that time SHA contacted Howard County for maintenance confirmation and was told the whole section of the road had been abandoned by Howard County and was now classified as a private road. Upon receiving this notification, the Data Services Division of SHA formally removed "Deadman's Curve" from the SHA inventory of roads.

According to research conducted by the Howard County Office of Law, while Howard County has not formally closed the former section of Washington Boulevard known as "Deadman's Curve," the Howard County Bureau of Highways ceased performing maintenance when it was determined that there were no longer residents in the immediate area (sometime in the 1980s). According to SHA, ownership of the roadbed of "Deadman's Curve" was never granted to the State of Maryland by deed, and the development and use of the roadbed was through prescriptive easement only. It is the Petitioner's understanding and belief that that the Howard County Office of Law, likewise, does not believe the County has any direct ownership of "Deadman's Curve" and that the transfer agreement of 1955 (**Exhibit F**) does not grant any such ownership rights.

Since the realignment of MD 597, Deadman's Curve has been maintained by the owners of the Properties and is physically used for access to and from Washington Boulevard by all three (3) parcels constituting the Properties. As such, the Petitioner does not believe that the closure of "Deadman's Curve," which has operated as a de-facto private road for decades, will affect public traffic patterns or circulation in any way and, thus, does not necessitate any changes to traffic control in the area.

For your convenience and reference, the names and addresses of all abutting property owners (as of the date of this request) is included herewith. Additionally, please find enclosed a check in the amount of \$1,500.00 as the required fee under 18.204(e) of the Howard County Code for the subject road closure petition.



Through the passage of the Turnpike Act of 1812, Chapter 78, the Maryland General Assembly chartered the Washington and Baltimore Turnpike Company to construct and operate a turnpike road between the District of Columbia and the Baltimore City. The turnpike road constructed under the Act is now known as U.S. Route 1 (Maryland), with that portion running through Howard County, Maryland in the area of the Properties known locally as Washington Boulevard. The present-day location of the "Deadman's Curve" roadbed represents a portion of the original alignment of Washington Boulevard.

Through a series of Plats recorded by the State Roads Commission of Maryland ("SRC") in 1942 (Plat Nos. 5549 - 5551), all entitled "Balto & Wash Blv'd Relocation of Deadmans Curve So of Elkridge," "Deadman's Curve" was straightened out in connection with the realignment and expansion of Washington Boulevard into a four (4) lane road (See Exhibit D attached hereto). Upon the relocation of "Deadman's Curve," this section of Washington Boulevard was renamed MD 597. After construction of the new four (4) lane Washington Blvd, the SRC transferred maintenance of MD 597 and the stub section known as "Deadman's Curve" to Howard County, Maryland in December 1955 (See <u>Exhibits E</u> and <u>F</u> attached hereto). Upon the transfer, this portion of the roadbed was re-numbered County Route (CO) 277 When County Route (CO) 277 was re-inventoried in 1969 by the SHA, the "Deadman's Curve" section was found to have been in use by a construction company and when re-inventoried in 2001, SHA found it to have been barricaded about 0.12 mile into the roadway (See Exhibits G and H attached hereto). At that time SHA contacted Howard County for maintenance confirmation and was told the whole section of the road had been abandoned by Howard County and was now classified as a private road. Upon receiving this notification, the Data Services Division of SHA formally removed "Deadman's Curve" from the SHA inventory of roads.

According to research conducted by the Howard County Office of Law, while Howard County has not formally closed the former section of Washington Boulevard known as "Deadman's Curve," the Howard County Bureau of Highways ceased performing maintenance when it was determined that there were no longer residents in the immediate area (sometime in the 1980s). According to SHA, ownership of the roadbed of "Deadman's Curve" was never granted to the State of Maryland by deed, and the development and use of the roadbed was through prescriptive easement only. It is the Petitioner's understanding and belief that that the Howard County Office of Law, likewise, does not believe the County has any direct ownership of "Deadman's Curve" and that the transfer agreement of 1955 (Exhibit F) does not grant any such ownership rights.

Since the realignment of MD 597, Deadman's Curve has been maintained by the owners of the Properties and is physically used for access to and from Washington Boulevard by all three (3) parcels constituting the Properties. As such, the Petitioner does not believe that the closure of "Deadman's Curve," which has operated as a de-facto private road for decades, will affect public traffic patterns or circulation in any way and, thus, does not necessitate any changes to traffic control in the area.

For your convenience and reference, the names and addresses of all abutting property owners (as of the date of this request) is included herewith. Additionally, please find enclosed a check in the amount of \$1,500.00 as the required fee under 18.204(e) of the Howard County Code for the subject road closure petition.




