6	CAPACITY UTILIZATION RATE OF 100% OR LESS;
7	(II) ESTIMATED STUDENT GENERATION FROM THE PROJECT;
8	(III) ANY POTENTIAL FOR THE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO ADD CAPACITY
9	TO THE IMPACTED SCHOOL OR SCHOOLS THROUGH REDISTRICTING,
10	FACILITY EXPANSION, OR OTHER PROGRAMS; AND
11	(III) THE NEED FOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING IN THE COUNTY, INCLUDING
12	FACTORS SUCH AS THE HOUSING COST BURDEN ON FAMILIES AND
13	THE EXTENT OF HOMELESSNESS AMONG FAMILIES AND SCHOOL
14	CHILDREN.".
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
