1	WHEREAS, on October 30, 2006, the County Council of Howard County
2	adopted Council Resolution No. 143-2006 ("CR 143-2006"); and

4	WHEREAS, CR 143-2006 declared that it was in the interest of the public health,
5	safety, and welfare of the citizens of Howard County to accept the dedication of a portion of
6	Forrest Avenue abutting lots 677 through 726 which is from the existing paved terminus at
7	Highland Avenue to its western most point as shown on the plat entitled "Plat of Har-wood"
8	recorded among the Land Records of Howard County, Maryland at liber 60, folio 155 in
9	1893; and

11	WHEREAS, a copy of CR 143-2006 is attached as Exhibit A; and

13	WHEREAS, CR 143-2006 was considered by the Council because the County
4	had received Final Plan F-06-133 for the construction of moderately priced residential
15	units to be accessed by a newly constructed public road on that portion of Forrest Avenue
16	abutting lots 677 through 726 from the existing paved terminus of the publicly owned
17	portion of Forest Avenue at Highland Avenue to the western most point of Forrest Avenue
8	as shown on the Harwood Park Plat; and

20	WHEREAS, the construction of such portion of Forrest Avenue is to be in
21	accordance with the County's current standards for construction of a public road and
22	Meadowlark LLC, the developer of F-06-133, is willing to construct such portion of Forrest
23	Avenue at its expense; and

25	WHEREAS, CR 143-2006 provided that the acceptance of that portion of Forest
26	Avenue would be null and void with no further action required by the Council if
27	construction was not commenced on or before December 31, 2008; and

29	WHEREAS, on November 13, 2007, the Developer entered into a Developer
80	Agreement with the County and posted all security to cover the construction of the
31	roadway; and

1	WHEREAS, due to the economy, the Developer has not been able to begin the
2	actual construction of the project; and

4	WHEREAS, because the Developer entered into a Developer Agreement and
5	posted all necessary security to cover the project, the County now wishes to give the
6	Developer more time to begin construction; and

8	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard
9	County, Maryland, that, in order to provide the Developer with time to begin
10	construction, page 2, lines 10 through 12 of Council Resolution No. 143-2006 are



1	WHEREAS, prior to the establishment of Howard County, Maryland as a charter form
2	of government and the adoption of the Howard County Zoning Regulations ("Zoning
3	Regulations") and the Howard County Subdivision and Land Development Regulations
4	("Subdivision Regulations"), a certain parcel of land was subdivided and streets for the ingress
5	and egress to the lots were set forth on a recorded plat entitled "Plat of Har-wood" recorded
6	among the Land Records of Howard County, Maryland at liber 60, folio 155 in the year 1893, a
7	copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A ("Harwood Park Plat"); and
8	
9	WHEREAS, at the time of the recordation of the Harwood Park Plat, there was not a
10	requirement that the owner of the subdivided property construct the streets shown on the plat;
11	and
12	WHEREAS, the Harwood Park Plat constitutes an offer of dedication of the streets
13	shown on the Harwood Park Plat for use by the public for the ingress and egress to the lots
14	created in the Harwood Park Plat; and
15	
16	WHEREAS, a portion of the public road known as "Forest Avenue" between Athol
17	Avenue and Highland Avenue was accepted into the Howard County Road System as a
18	prescriptive road in 1961 by the County Commissioners of Howard County, Maryland; and
19	
20	WHEREAS, the County has received Final Plan F-06-133 for the construction of
21	moderately priced residential units to be accessed by a newly constructed public road on that
22	portion of Forrest Avenue abutting lots 677 through 726 from the existing paved terminus of the
23	publicly owned portion of Forest Avenue at Highland Avenue to the western most point of Forrest
24	Avenue as shown on the Harwood Park Plat; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, the construction of such portion of Forrest Avenue shall be in accordance with
27	the County's current standards for construction of a public road and the developer of F-06-133 is
28	willing to construct such portion of Forrest Avenue at its expense; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, the County desires to accept the offer of dedication of Forrest Avenue (laid
21	out as forty (40) feet in width) abutting lots 677 through 726 which is from the existing paved

terminus of Forest Avenue at Highland Avenue to the western most point of Forrest Avenue as shown on the Harwood Park Plat to provide a public road for the ingress and egress to such lots.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that it is in the interest of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Howard County to accept the offer of dedication of Forrest Avenue forty (40) feet in width abutting lots 677 through 726 which is from the existing paved and publicly maintained terminus of Forest Avenue at Highland Avenue to the western most point of Forrest Avenue as shown on the Harwood Park Plat.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, if the construction of Forrest Avenue is not commenced on or before December 31, 2008 pursuant to F-06-133 then this resolution shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the County Council.

The Department of Public Works has been designated coordinator for the preparation of testimony relative to amending a provision in Council Resolution No. 143-2006 that required certain construction on or before December 31, 2008 or the County's acceptance of a portion of Forrest Avenue would be null and void.

In 2006, Resolution 143-2006 was approved to identify Forrest Avenue as a public road. Page 2, Lines 10-12 of the Resolution required the developer to start construction of Forrest Avenue on or before December 31, 2008. On November 13, 2007, Meadowlark, LLC, the developer, entered into a developer agreement titled "Timber Ridge" (P&Z File No. F-06-133) for the construction of the public improvements and posted all security to cover the construction of the roadway. Due to the economy, the developer has not been able to start construction of his project.

Since the timeframe noted in the Resolution has passed, the department is requested that the Resolution be amended to remove the deadline date to allow the developer to move forward with construction of Forrest Avenue as soon as the economy improves. Upon the approval of this resolution, the department will amend the developer agreement to grant the developer additional time to complete construction.

There is no fiscal impact to the County as all work will be done by the developer.
