9	\$500 or fraction of \$500 of consideration payable or of the principal amount of debt secured for	
10	an instrument of writing, the tax to be imposed on the instrument of writing prior to recordation	
11	with the Clerk of the Court; and

13	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the recordation tax rate shall be effective July 1,	
14	2012 and shall continue in effect until changed or repealed by subsequent resolution of the	
15	County Council.
