17 (1) The consumer price index to be used is the index for "All Urban Consumers
18 (CPI-U) BALTIMORE-COLUMBIA-TOWSON, MD, ALL ITEMS, AS PUBLISHED BY THE
19 UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, [[Washington-Baltimore, DC-MD-VA-
20 WV—All items—November 1996=100" published by the Bureau of Labor
21 Statistics]]; and the Consumer Price Index as of any valuation date means the
22 index reading on the last day of [[March]] FEBRUARY preceding such
23 valuation date.

24 (2) In the event the Bureau of Labor Statistics abandons publication of the index for
25 "All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) BALTIMORE-COLUMBIA-TOWSON, MD – ALL ITEMS
26 [[Washington-Baltimore, DC-MD-VA-WV—All items—November
27 1996=100]]" the County shall adopt any other index which, in its judgment,

(c) Definition of Consumer Price Index.

- (1) The consumer price index to be used is the index for "All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) BALTIMORE-COLUMBIA-TOWSON, MD, ALL ITEMS, AS PUBLISHED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, [[Washington-Baltimore, DC-MD-VA-WV—All items—November 1996=100" published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics]]; and the Consumer Price Index as of any valuation date means the index reading on the last day of [[March]] FEBRUARY preceding such valuation date.
- (2) In the event the Bureau of Labor Statistics abandons publication of the index for "All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) BALTIMORE-COLUMBIA-TOWSON, MD – ALL ITEMS [[Washington-Baltimore, DC-MD-VA-WV—All items—November 1996=100]]" the County shall adopt any other index which, in its judgment, provides an accurate measure of cost-of-living changes.

Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland that *this Act shall become effective 61 days after its enactment.*
