2	Purchasing Agent, with the approval of the County Executive and the County Council, to sell or
3	lease surplus supplies to the State or any political subdivision or agency of the State, or to the
4	Federal Government upon such terms and conditions as the County Purchasing Agent deems
5	proper; and

7	WHEREAS, the Department of Technology and Communication Services has an IBM
8	z800 - Model 0E1 - Mainframe computer (FAICS tag numbers 117197 and 117198); and

10	WHEREAS, the mainframe is no longer needed for County purposes; and

12	WHEREAS, the Department of Technology and Communication Services has requested
13	the County Purchasing Agent to authorize the sale, for nominal consideration, of the mainframe
14	to the Charles County Public School System; and

16	WHEREAS, the County Executive has approved the sale, for nominal consideration, of
17	the surplus mainframe to the Charles County Public School System.

19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Howard County,
20	Maryland this 4th day of June, 2012 that it approves the sale of the mainframe which is
21	no longer needed by the County for public purposes to the Charles County Public School System
22	for nominal consideration.
