5	WHEREAS, the State of Emergency declared by Executive Order 2018-07, and extended by CR				
6	84, will expire on July 3, 2018, unless extended by the County Council; and				
7	WHEREAS, the hazardous conditions will continue beyond July 3, 2018; and				
8	WHEREAS, extending the State of Emergency is necessary to protect public health, safety, and				
9	9 welfare and to protect property.
