1           **WHEREAS**, the Howard County Council will adopt a new General Plan for Howard  
2 County, Maryland entitled *PlanHoward 2030*, for the purpose of planning for land use and land  
3 conservation in the County for the next 10 years; and

5           **WHEREAS**, countywide, the changes proposed in the draft *PlanHoward 2030* address  
6 the quality of life, public participation, environmental protection, resource conservation,  
7 economic development, growth, transportation, infrastructure and services, housing, and  
8 community design; and

10           **WHEREAS**, the County Council believes a review and reporting on the impact of  
11 *PlanHoward 2030* by the various County Boards and Commissions is necessary to evaluate the  
12 merits of the proposed General Plan; and

14           **WHEREAS**, County Council believes a review and reporting on *PlanHoward 2030* by  
15 the County's Boards and Commissions will encourage public trust and confidence in local  
16 government and the General Plan.

18           **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the County Council of Howard County,

20 identified in this Resolution, are requested to review and report to the County Council, by July 2,
