1	WHEREAS, on March 5, 2018, the County Council approved Council Bill No. 12-2018
2	("CB 12"), which requires a permit for concerts and for special events such as parades, public
3	assemblies, athletic events and block parties; and
4	
5	WHEREAS, as enacted by CB 12, Howard County Code Section 17.905 provides that
6	the County shall charge a non-refundable application fee for Special Event and Concert Permits
7	and the application fee is due upon application for a permit; and
8	
9	WHEREAS, in conjunction with its approval of CB 12, the Council adopted Council
10	Resolution No. 24-2018 that adopted an application fee for Special Event and Concert Permits
11	and that was effective when CB 12 was effective; and
12	
13	WHEREAS, Section 17.905 also provides that the County Council shall adopt by
14	resolution a fee schedule for Special Event and Concert Permits; and
15	
16	WHEREAS, special events and concerts provide substantial benefits to the County in
17	that they provide cultural enrichment, promote economic vitality, enhance community identity
18	and pride, and provide fundraising opportunities for nonprofit organizations in the County; and
19	
20	WHEREAS, special events require significant resources from County agencies to protect
21	the public's health, safety and welfare; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, over the past few years, the County has incurred significant costs related to
24	special events and the County wishes to recover some of those costs; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, it is important to the County to continue to support small special events and
27	events promoted by nonprofit entities as a method to raise funds for their causes; and

1	WHEREAS, accordingly, the fee schedule provides that permit fees for nonprofit entities
2	will not be accessed until estimated costs exceed \$1,500 and will be assessed on that portion of
3	estimated costs that exceed \$1,500.
4	
5	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Howard County,
6 7	Maryland this <u>3</u> day of <u>May</u> , 2018 that it adopts the attached schedule of fees.
8	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution and attached fee schedule
9	shall be effective on July 1, 2018 and shall continue in effect until changed or repealed by a
10	subsequent Resolution.
11	
12	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that permit fees are based on the calendar year
13	and will not be charged until January 1, 2019.
14	
15	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, through June 30, 2018, the application fees
16	set by Council Resolution No. 24-2018 shall remain in effect.
17	
18	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, effective July 1, 2018, the application fees
19	set by Council Resolution No. 24-2018 are repealed and application fees included in the attached
20	Fee Schedule shall be in effect.

FEES FOR SPECIAL EVENT AND CONCERT PERMITS

This fee is set pursuant to Section 17.905 of the Howard County Code that allows the County to charge an application fee and permit fees.

I. Application Fees

A.	Non-refundable Application Fee for a Special Event:	\$50.00
B.	Non-refundable Application Fee for a Concert:	\$200.00

II. Permit Fees

Permit Fee for Special Events¹ (Effective beginning January 1, 2019): Cost to the County to be computed as follows:

\$64.81 times the number of estimated hours of service for each employee of the County providing services to support the event, subject to the following:

When the event promoter is a Nonprofit Organization
Fee estimated to be \$1,500 or less - No Charge
Fee exceeds \$1,500 - Applicant shall pay 50% of the amount that exceeds
\$1,500

When the event promoter is a For-Profit OrganizationApplicant shall pay 100% of the Fee

¹ Note that parades and block parties are exempt from permit fees under Section 17.905 of the Code. The County may exempt an applicant from a permit or application fee, or both, if the County determines that such a waiver is in the best interest of the County.
