3 **Section 1. Be It Enacted** by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that:

- 4 1. *The schedule of fees and charges for functions regulated by the Howard County*
5 *Department of Inspections, Licenses and Permits, as set by Resolution No. 62-2017,*
6 *as amended by Resolution No. 57-2018, is hereby amended, for each of the following*
7 *schedules:*

8 *Building, Grading & Miscellaneous Construction Permits*

9 *Fire Protection Permits*

10 *Building Permit & Miscellaneous Fees*

11 *Fire Protection Permit Fees*

12 *Grading, Drainage, and Erosion Control Permit Fees*

13 *Electrical Fee Schedules*

14 *Electrical Permit Fee Schedule*

15 *Plumbing Fees*

16 *Schedule of Plumbing Permit Fees, and*

17 *Heating, Ventilation, Air-Conditioning, and Refrigeration Permit; and,*

- 18 2. *The Food Service Facility Fee Schedule for certain functions regulated by the*
19 *Howard County Department of Health, as set by Resolution No. 111-2012, is hereby*
20 *amended, for each of the following:*

21 *Food Service Facility Licenses*

22 *Temporary Food Service Facility*

- 23 3. *For each of the schedules referenced in Items 1 and 2, for permits and licenses to*
24 *perform work located anywhere in Howard County arising from the May 28, 2018*
25 *disaster, as declared by Executive Order 2018-07, the fee shall be \$0.00 (zero dollars*
26 *and zero cents), provided a valid permit or license application is submitted during the*
27 *period May 28, 2018 through January 31, 2019. This shall apply to properties*
28 *included on the County's list of properties damaged as a result of the 2018 floods,*
29 *and to properties for which the owners provide information satisfactory to the County*
30 *demonstrating that the properties were damaged as a result of the 2018 floods.*

1 4. The schedule for charges pertaining to the Metropolitan District, to water and sewer
2 service, and to shared sewage disposal facilities, as set by Resolution No. 60-2017, as
3 amended by Resolution No. 55-2018, is hereby amended, for each of the following
4 schedules:
5 General System Benefit Charge
6 In-Aid-Of-Construction Charges
7 Charges for Unmetered Water Connections Associated With Private Fire
8 Protection Systems
9 Utility Connection Charges
10 Design Approval, Construction Inspection, And Annual Operation, Maintenance,
11 Repair, And Replacement Fees For Shared Sewage Disposal Facilities
12 Annual Operation, Maintenance, Repair And Replacement Fees
13 Utility User Charges And Surcharges Industrial Pre-treatment And Sewer
14 Surcharge Rates
15 Utility Special Charges

17 5. For each of the schedules listed in Item 4, charges incurred for the time period from
18 May 27, 2018 through January 31, 2019, shall be \$0.00 (zero dollars and zero cents)
19 for the property accounts associated with properties located shown in red shading on
20 the map attached as Exhibit A.

22 **Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted** by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that
23 *this Act is an Emergency Bill that is necessary to protect the public health, safety, and welfare*
24 *and, having been passed by two-thirds of the Council, is effective upon enactment.*
