AN ACT amending a tax credit against the County tax imposed on real property that is owned by individuals who are a retired member of the Armed Forces of the United States to provide that certain surviving spouses of retired members of the Armed Forces are eligible to receive the property tax credit; and generally relating to real property tax credits.

1 **WHEREAS**, by passage of House Bill No. 502, the 2018 General Assembly of Maryland
2 altered the eligibility criteria for the tax credit offered for specified retired members of the U.S.
3 Armed Forces by adding the surviving spouse, who has not remarried, of the retired service
4 member as an eligible recipient of the property tax credit; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the County Executive wishes to extend this tax credit to the surviving
7 spouses, who have not remarried, of retired members of the U.S. Armed Forces in Howard
8 County.

10 **NOW, THEREFORE,**

12 **Section 1. Be It Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland that the Howard**
13 **County Code is amended as follows:**

15 *By amending Title 20 “Taxes, Charges, and Fees”*

23 **Section 20.129E. Property tax credit for Seniors and Retired Military Personnel.**

24 **(b) Credit Established and Eligibility.** In accordance with section 9-258 of the Tax-Property
25 Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the owner of a dwelling may receive a property tax
26 credit against the county property tax imposed on the property containing the dwelling if the
27 property is owned by an individual:

28 (1) Who is at least 65 years old and has lived in the same dwelling for at least the
29 preceding 40 years; [[or]]

30 (2) Who is at least 65 years old and is a retired member of the Armed Forces of the
31 United States[.]; OR

1 (3) A SURVIVING SPOUSE, WHO HAS NOT REMARRIED, OF AN INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED IN
2 PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

4 *Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland that*
5 *the changes made by this Act shall apply beginning in the taxable year beginning July 1, 2018.*

7 *Section 3. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland that*
8 *this Act shall become effective 61 days after its enactment.*
