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Amendment No. 109
(This amendment returns most of the proposed language in the CAC district back to the existing CAC language).

Make the following changes to the Comprehensive Zoning Plan attached to the Bill:

On page 323 , in line 9 , strike both sets of brackets. On the same page, in lines 46,47 , and 52 , strike all of the new brackets. On the same page, in lines 52 and 53 strike "SMALLER SITES IF ADJOINING AN EXISTING CAC DEVELOPMENT.".

On page 325 , in line 17 , strike the new brackets and " 65 ". On the same page, in lines 19 through 30, strike all of the new brackets. And in lines 24 and 25, strike "(1)" and "(2)", respectively.

On page 326 , in line 16 and 22 , strike the new brackets.

On page 327, in line 5, strike the new brackets and "BUILDINGS CLOSEST TO ROUTE 1 ". On the same page, in lines 9 through 15, strike all of the new brackets. And in line 14 , strike "FROM THE PUBLIC SIDEWALKS.". Also, strike all of the new brackets in lines 32 through 54. In line 41 , strike "a." and "Route 1 ". In line 42 , strike "MAY". In line 44 , strike "IF".

On page 328 , in line 2 , strike both sets of double brackets and "b." and " 100 ". On the same page, in line 4 , strike the new brackets. Again on the same page, beginning in line 5 , strike the new brackets. Also on line 5, strike after "conditions:" through the new brackets in line 12. And strike the new brackets in lines 16. Also, on page 328, strike lines 18 through 21 in their entirety and substitute:
"BASED ON DOCUMENTED HARDSHIP, THE PLANNING DIRECTOR MAY FURTHER REDUCE
THE COMMERCIAL SPACE REQUIREMENT TO 70 SQUARE FEET PER ACRE FOR PARCELS THAT HAVE
800 UNITS OR MORE, PROVIDED THE CRITERIA LISTED IN B. (1) AND (2) IS USED IN THE
EVALUATION.".

On the same page, in lines 26 through 29, strike all the new brackets and prior to "no" insert, "FOR DEVELOPMENTS OF 800 UNITS OR MORE," and on line 26 replace " 75 " with " 60. ."

Lastly, in lines 43 and 44, strike the new brackets and "UP TO A MAXIMUM OF 35 UNITS PER NET ACRE".
