- 16 1. Ambulance services.
- 17 2. Ambulatory health care facilities.
- 18 3. Athletic and recreation facilities, including:
  - 19 a. Bowling alleys, billiard parlors, skating rinks, dance halls and similar  
20 uses.
  - 21 b. Miniature golf courses and golf driving ranges.
  - 22 c. Community and commercial swimming pools.
  - 23 d. Athletic fields, tennis clubs, athletic centers, health clubs.
- 24 4. Banks, savings and loan associations, investment companies, credit bureaus,  
25 brokers and similar financial institutions.
- 26 5. Biomedical laboratories.
- 27 6. Blueprinting, printing, duplicating or engraving services.
- 28 7. BREWERIES THAT MANUFACTURE 10,000 BARRELS OR LESS OF FERMENTED

**Howard County Zoning Regulations**  
**SECTION 123.0: M-2 (Manufacturing: Heavy) District**

**B. Uses Permitted as a Matter of Right**

- 1. All uses permitted as a matter of right in the M-1 District.
- 2. BREWERIES THAT MANUFACTURE MORE THAN 10,000 BARRELS OF FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGES PER YEAR.

{Renumber subsequent categories accordingly}

*Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland that the Director of the Department of Planning and Zoning is authorized to publish this Act, to correct obvious errors in section references, numbers and references to existing law, capitalization, spelling, grammar, headings and similar matters.*

*Section 3. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that this Act shall become effective 61 days after its enactment.*
