AN ACT transferring a total of \$650,000 from certain capital projects within the Board of Education's capital budget to capital project E1044, Systemic Renovations, and capital project, E0989, Barrier-Free Projects.

1           **WHEREAS**, the following capital projects are in their final stages of completion and the  
2 Board of Education would like to transfer funds from the projects as follows:

- 3           1. \$300,000 from E1031, Wilde Lake Middle School Replacement;
- 4           2. \$200,000 from E1034, Swansfield Elem School Renovation/Addition; and
- 5           3. \$150,000 from E1028, New Elementary School #42 (a.k.a Hanover Hills Elementary  
6 School); and

8           **WHEREAS**, funding is available from each of these projects because of cost savings  
9 realized during construction and sufficient funds remain to complete each project; and

10  
11           **WHEREAS**, funding in the amount of \$500,000 will be transferred to E1044, Systemic  
12 Renovations in order to address HVAC needs; and

13  
14           **WHEREAS**, funding in the amount of \$150,000 will be transferred to E0989, Barrier-  
15 Free Projects, in order to complete sink modifications in various schools; and

16  
17           **WHEREAS**, Section 609(b) of the Howard County Charter authorizes and empowers the  
18 Howard County Council to make such transfers; and

19  
20           **WHEREAS**, the Board of Education has indicated that the funds are available for  
21 transfer from the respective projects.

23           *Section 1. Be It Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that,*  
24 *subject to the provisions of Maryland law, the Howard County Charter, and the Howard County*  
25 *Code relating to the budgetary and fiscal procedures, the amount hereafter specified is hereby*  
26 *approved, appropriated, and authorized to be disbursed for the general County purposes*  
27 *specified and in sums itemized for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018 and ending June 30,*


