1	WHEREAS, the County Council has adopted the Annual Budget and Appropriation		
2	Ordinance and, having considered the amounts necessary to provide for emergency medical		
3	treatment, fire suppression, prevention, and related functions, finds it necessary to levy a fire and		
4	rescue tax in order to fund the County's operating and capital costs to provide fire and emergency		
5	services; and		
6			
7	WHEREAS, as a result of changes made in the method of assessing the value of real		
8	property by Chapter 80 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2000, the rate of the tax as		
9	applied to operating personal and real property of a public utility is 2.5 times the rate of the tax		
10	applied to real property; and		
11			
12	WHEREAS, since 1992, the County has had two separate fire tax districts; and		
13			
14	WHEREAS, on March 29, 2011, the County Council passed Council Bill 9-2013 that		
15	eliminated the separate fire districts and created a single fire tax district.		
16			
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard County,		
18	Maryland, this 23 day of May, , 2013, pursuant to the provisions of Section 17.102		
19	of the Howard County Code, that a Howard County Fire and Rescue Tax is levied upon all		
20	assessable property in the County beginning July 1, 2013 in the following amounts per \$100 of		
21	assessed valuation:

23	Fiscal Year 2014 rate per \$100 assessed value 17.6 cents

25	Fiscal Year 2014 rate per \$100 assessed value for 44 cents		
26	operating personal property and operating real property		
27	owned by public utilities

29	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Fire and Rescue Tax rates shall become		
30	effective July 1, 2013 and shall continue in effect until changed or repealed by subsequent action		
31	of the County Council.
