1	BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that
2	Section 209 "Legislative procedure" subsection (h) "Failure of bills", of Article II, "The
3	Legislative Branch", of the Howard County Charter, be, and is hereby amended to read
4	as follows:

6	Section 209. Legislative Procedure.
7	
8	(h) Failure of bills. Any bill not passed within sixty-five calendar days after its
9	introduction shall fail, unless, by affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members,
10	the Council shall extend the deadline for another thirty days. The COUNCIL MAY
11	APPROVE A MAXIMUM OF TWO SUCH EXTENSIONS FOR EACH BILL.

13	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard
14	County, Maryland, that at the next general election to be held in Maryland, the proposed
15	amendment to the Howard County Charter shall be submitted to the voters of Howard
16	County for their adoption or rejection in accordance with the provisions of the Article X
17	of the Howard County Charter and Article XIA of the Maryland Constitution, and if
18	adopted by the majority of the voters, shall stand adopted from and after the 30^{th} day
19	following the general election;

21	AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard
22	County, Maryland, that this Resolution, having been approved by two-thirds of the
23	members of the Howard County Council, stands adopted this day of
24	, 2012 in accordance with Article X of the Howard County Charter.
