The Department of Public Works has been designated coordinator for preparation of testimony relative to the above referenced Council Resolution that provides for the conveyance of an easement to the Baltimore Gas and Electric Company (BGE) located on County property shown as Parcels 11, 12, and 109 on Tax Map 25 (commonly known as the Howard Complex).

BGE requires an easement on County property in order to provide better electrical services to the surrounding County office buildings.

A right of entry was granted to BGE in order to allow the replacement of the electric lines to continue while a permanent easement is conveyed. Attached is a Council Resolution authorizing the County Executive to grant an easement to BGE. BGE will not be required to compensate the County for this easement.

There is no fiscal impact to the County. BGE will bear all costs for construction.
