1           **WHEREAS**, Section 610 of the Howard County Charter authorizes and empowers  
 2 the Howard County Council to make supplementary appropriations from the unexpended  
 3 and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget; and

5           **WHEREAS**, the County has been awarded a grant in the total amount of  
 6 \$1,818,450 which will be dispersed over several years from the Maryland Department of  
 7 the Environment as part of the Clean Water Commerce Act Grant; and

9           **WHEREAS**, the amount that can be received per year is \$746,520; and  
 10

11           **WHEREAS**, grant funding will be used for the Little Patuxent Water Reclamation  
 12 Plant Advanced Process Instrumentation and Control System (APICS) project to address  
 13 nutrient removal and to provide additional nitrogen and phosphorus reductions; and

15           **WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be  
 16 transferred is not encumbered and is available for transfer.


