1 **WHEREAS**, on July 25, 2013 the County Council approved Council Bill 32-2013,
2 adopting the Comprehensive Zoning Plan; and

4 **WHEREAS**, before approving Council Bill 32-2013, the Council rejected Amendment
5 No. 131, which proposed amending the bill in order to place the property shown on Map 14.002
6 in the RR-DEO instead of the POR zoning classification, but the enrolled, signed bill incorrectly
7 showed the property as being in the RR-DEO zoning classification as if Amendment 131 had
8 passed; and

10 **WHEREAS**, once a Council bill has been enrolled and signed, the only way to change
11 the bill is to approve a corrective Council bill amending the original bill; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the County Council wishes to amend Council Bill 32-2013 in order to
14 ensure that the bill accurately reflects the Council's vote on Amendment No. 131 and the zoning
15 classification for the property shown on Map 14.002 and change the corresponding Map
16 Amendments Summary Chart.

20 *Section 1. Be It Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that County*
21 *Council Bill 32-2013 is hereby amended by substituting the Map 14.002 attached to this Act for*
22 *the corresponding map attached to Council Bill 32-2013 and making the corresponding change*
23 *in the Map Amendments Summary Chart.*

25 *Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that*
26 *this Act shall take effect 61 days after its enactment.*
