9 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (B), (C) AND (D) OF THIS SECTION, THE
10 ANNUAL SALARY OF THE CHAIRPERSON AND THE OTHER MEMBERS OF THE
11 COUNTY COUNCIL FOR THE FOUR YEAR TERM BEGINNING ON THE DATE IN
12 DECEMBER OF 2014 ON WHICH COUNCIL MEMBERS TAKE OFFICE SHALL BE
13 CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

- 14 (1) BEGINNING ON THE DATE OF INSTALLATION IN DECEMBER 2014, THE
15 BASE SALARY SHALL BE \$59,950 PER YEAR;
- 16 (2) THE SALARY SHALL INCREASE ANNUALLY ON THE ANNIVERSARY
17 DATE BEGINNING IN DECEMBER OF 2015 AND FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT
18 YEAR OF THE TERM;
- 19 (3) THE SALARY IN DECEMBER 2015 AND FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT YEAR
20 OF THE TERM SHALL BE EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT OF THE BASE SALARY
21 IN THE PREVIOUS YEAR INCREASED BY THE GREATER OF 2.5 PERCENT
22 OVER THE BASE OF THE PRECEDING YEAR OR THE SAME PERCENTAGE
23 AS THE INCREASE IN THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX FOR ALL URBAN
24 CONSUMERS (CPI-U WASHINGTON-BALTIMORE DC-MD-VA-WV
25 AVERAGE), ALL ITEMS, UNADJUSTED ("CPI-U INDEX") FOR THE 12
26 MONTH PERIOD ENDING ON JANUARY 31 OF THE YEAR FOR WHICH THE
27 NEW SALARY BASE IS CALCULATED. THIS NEW SALARY SHALL
28 BECOME THE BASE FOR THE CALCULATION OF THE SALARY FOR THE
29 SUBSEQUENT YEAR;
- 30 (4) IN THE EVENT THE BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS ABANDONS
31 PUBLICATION OF THE CPI-U INDEX, THE BASE SALARY FOR MEMBERS

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OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL SHALL BE INCREASED BY 2.5 PERCENT
OVER THE BASE OF THE PRECEDING YEAR.

(B) IN ADDITION TO THE BASE SALARY CALCULATED FOR MEMBERS OF THE
COUNTY COUNCIL, THE COUNCIL CHAIRPERSON SHALL RECEIVE AN
ADDITIONAL \$3,500 ANNUALLY.

~~(C) COUNCIL MEMBERS SHALL ALSO BE ALLOCATED \$3,500 UPON ELECTION OR
RE-ELECTION FOR THEIR TERM OF OFFICE IN THE COUNCIL BUDGET FOR THE
PURCHASE OF TECHNOLOGY OR ELECTRONIC DEVICES THAT ARE NOT
PROVIDED BY THE COUNTY BUT ASSIST IN THE PERFORMANCE AND
OBLIGATIONS OF THEIR DUTIES.~~

~~(D)~~ (C) IN ADDITION TO THE SALARY AUTHORIZED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS
SECTION, EACH MEMBER OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO
RECEIVE THE SAME EMPLOYEE BENEFITS AS ARE ESTABLISHED EACH YEAR
FOR FULL-TIME COUNTY EMPLOYEES.

~~(E)~~ (D) EACH COUNCIL MEMBER SHALL ALSO RECEIVE A MONTHLY STIPEND OF
\$150 TO BE USED FOR A SERVICE PLAN FOR THE WORK-RELATED USE OF A
