13 (b) *Appointing Authorities.* Appointing authorities for Executive exempt employees are as
14 provided in this subsection:

15 (5) Fire and Rescue Services. The Chief of Fire and Rescue Services, with the approval of the
16 County Executive, is the appointing authority for the: Deputy Chief;¹ [[and]] the Medical
17 Director, THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, and the
18 Assistant Administrator.

21 ¹A Howard County classified employee appointed to this position automatically reverts to the
22 employee's prior rank in the classified service upon removal from the position, unless the removal
23 is based upon such cause as would justify the termination of a classified employee.

25 **Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted** by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland that
26 *this Act shall become effective 61 days after its enactment.*

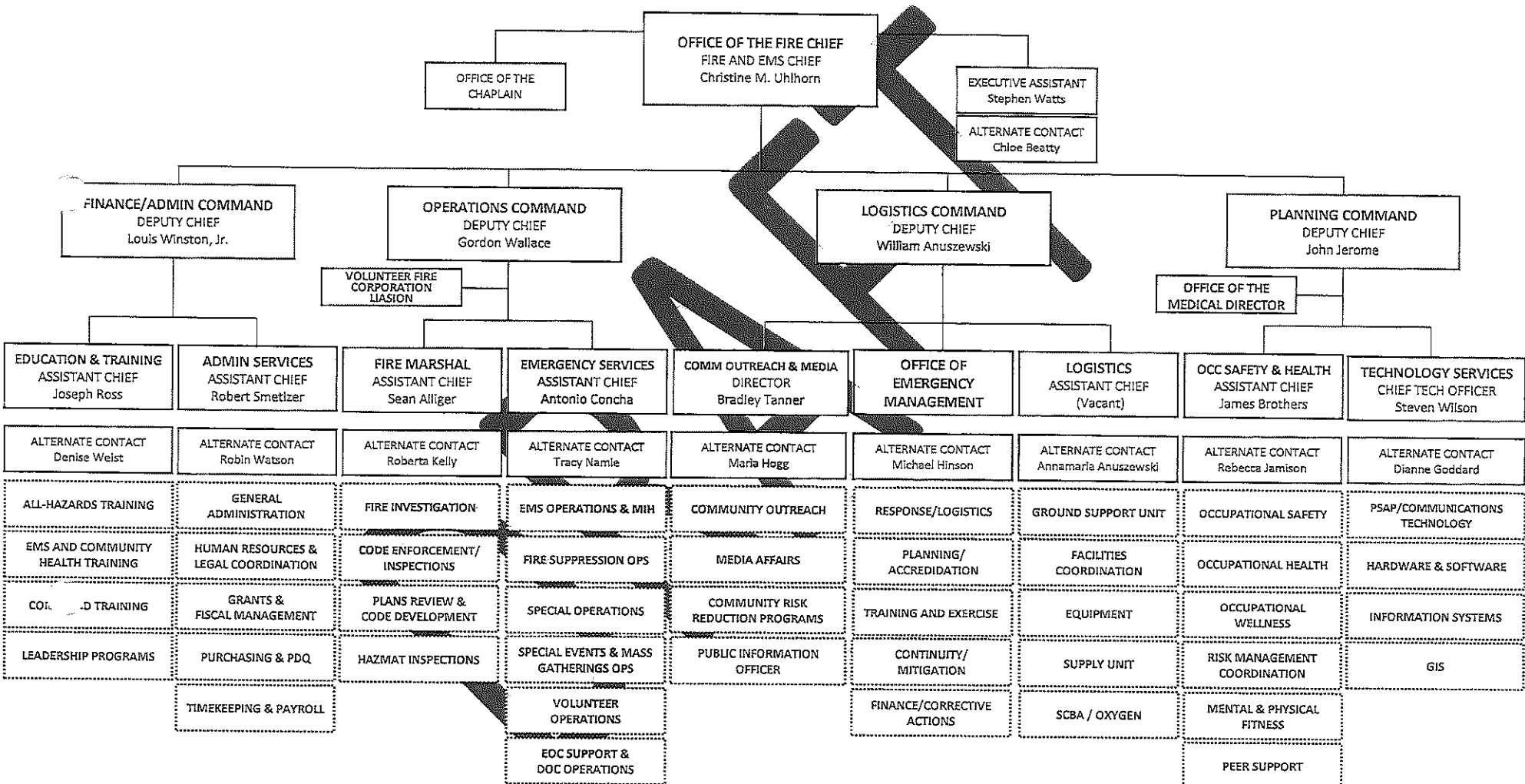

1. The 'alternate contact' is the designated member of each Bureau who is available to provide information and/or assistance in the absence of the Bureau Chief or designee.
 2. Other Bureaus are secondary responsibilities of each Deputy Chief. This provides continuity of operations in the event any Deputy Chief is not readily available.
