1	WHEREAS, Council Bill No. 24-2019 (CB24) is known as the Annual Budget and
2	Appropriation Ordinance of Howard County, Fiscal Year 2020 and contains the capital and
3	operating budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020; and

5	WHEREAS, because of the health emergency related to COVID-19, Congress recently
6	passed the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security ("CARES") Act which, in part,
7	provides financial aid to local jurisdictions to assist in the response to the public health and
8	economic impacts of COVID-19; and

10	WHEREAS, the Howard County Health Department (HCHD) and Howard County
11	Government have been notified that HCHD will be receiving \$28,415,197 from the CARES Act
12	through a grant from the State of Maryland, Department of Health and Mental Hygiene; and
13	
14	WHEREAS, the funding received by the HCHD will be used to cover eligible health-
15	related costs incurred in the response to COVID-19 by both HCHD and Howard County
16	Government, including but not limited to, the costs associated with short term hires and overtime
17	to support COVID operations, the purchase of Personal Protection Equipment, costs related to
18	testing and treating uninsured individuals, and other miscellaneous costs; and
19	
20	WHEREAS, the Howard County Government has also been notified that it will be
21	receiving an additional \$28,415,197 from the CARES Act through a grant from the State of
22	Maryland, Department of Budget and Management; and
23	
24	WHEREAS, the funding received by the Howard County Government will be used to
25	cover eligible costs incurred in response to COVID-19; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, the Howard County Office of Transportation ("OT") has also been notified
28	that it will be receiving up to \$7,461,399 from the CARES Act through a grant from the Federal
29	Transit Administration; and

31	WHEREAS, the funding received by the OT will be used to cover transit related operating

1	expenses and a revenue shortfall from transit fares.

3	WHEREAS, grant authority needs to be created in the Fiscal Year 2020 budget in orde	r
4	for Howard County Government to receive grant funds from:	
5	(1) the HCHD (as the grantor on behalf of the State Department of Health and Men	tal
6	Hygiene) for a grant in the amount of approximately \$28,415,197;	
7	(2) the State Department of Budget and Management for a grant in the amount of	
8	approximately \$28,415,197; and	
9	(3) the Federal Transit Administration for a grant in the amount of approximately	
10	\$7,461,399; and

12	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 610(b) of the Howard County Charter, this Emergence	y
13	Bill is necessary to meet a public emergency affecting life, health or property.

17	Section 1. Be It Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that the follows	ing
18	emergency appropriation of grant funds is authorized and approved for the fiscal year beginn	ing
19	July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020, as shown in the attached Exhibit A.

21	Section 2. And Be It Further Enacted that the Grant Fund total for Fiscal Year 2020 is	
22	amended to be \$89,541,587 as shown in the attached Exhibit A

24	Section 3. And Be It Further Enacted that new page 98A shall be inserted into and page 114	
25	shall be amended, both of the Fiscal Year 2020 Operating Budget attached to Council Bill No.	
26	24-2019, as shown in the attached Exhibit A.

28	Section 4. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland the	iat
29	this Act is adopted as an emergency measure to address an immediate emergency affecting	
30	public health, safety, or welfare and having been passed by two-thirds of its members, this Act	
31	shall be effective immediately upon its enactment.
