As I testified for SAO4-FY2020, if the SAO is only to address the special elections held for the 7th Congressional District and not the regular primary and general elections, then an amendment to Amendment 1 is needed. For transparency, consistency with the names of the different elections used by the Board of Elections, and clarity of drafting and interpretation "special" should be added before "general election" in the title and "a special" should be added before "general" in line 8 on page 1.

In addition, because the special general election was the first to be converted to a vote-by-mail election, why is it not also eligible for CARES Act funds?
