5 Ellicott City, Maryland 21043, and is a special education school and residential program for  
6 individuals living with autism and related developmental disabilities; and

8           **WHEREAS**, Linwood Center, Inc. has applied to the Department of Housing and  
9 Community Development of the State of Maryland for approval of an allocation of tax credits for  
10 business entities and individuals that contribute to the organization, under the Department's  
11 Community Investment Tax Credit Program; and

13           **WHEREAS**, the regulations of the Community Investment Tax Credit Program require  
14 that all projects receiving tax credits receive support from the appropriate governing body of the  
15 locality in which the project is situated.

19 proposed financing to Linwood Center, Inc.
