## Council Resolution No. 173-2020

# Fiscal Impact:

There is no fiscal impact of this legislation.

The proposed Purchasing Manual changes are primarily the result of Council Bill 62-2020, which changes the name of the Office of Purchasing and the Purchasing Administrator. There is no effect on County revenue or expense due to these changes to the Purchasing Manual.

## Purpose:

The purpose of this resolution is to update the Purchasing Manual to match modifications proposed in CB62-2020, which changes the name of the Office of Purchasing to the Office of Procurement and Contract Administration. Council Bill 62-2020 also changes the name of the Purchasing Administrator accordingly.

Council Resolution 173-2020 also proposes a change in the Mission Statement and makes two technical corrections noted below in Other Comments.

#### Other Comments:

The resolution amends the definition of "parked document" to include the following payment types:

- Real property acquisitions and leases;
- Refunds issued by county departments and offices;
- Utility payments; and
- Government entities

An incorrect reference to Section 4.103(w) of the County Code is removed from *Section 8 – Formal Purchase Report to County Council* (page 5 of the Purchasing Manual attached to the legislation).

If CB62-2020 fails, this resolution may require amendments to remove the corresponding name changes proposed in the bill.
