This legislation would update a technical reference in the previously passed legislation, Council Bill 11-2020, which becomes effective on September 6, 2020.

Council Bill 11-2020 requires documentation referencing design standards in the 2011 edition of "Pilot Credit #55: reducing bird collisions" in the LEED green building rating system. This revision to the County Code will reference the 2019 edition.
