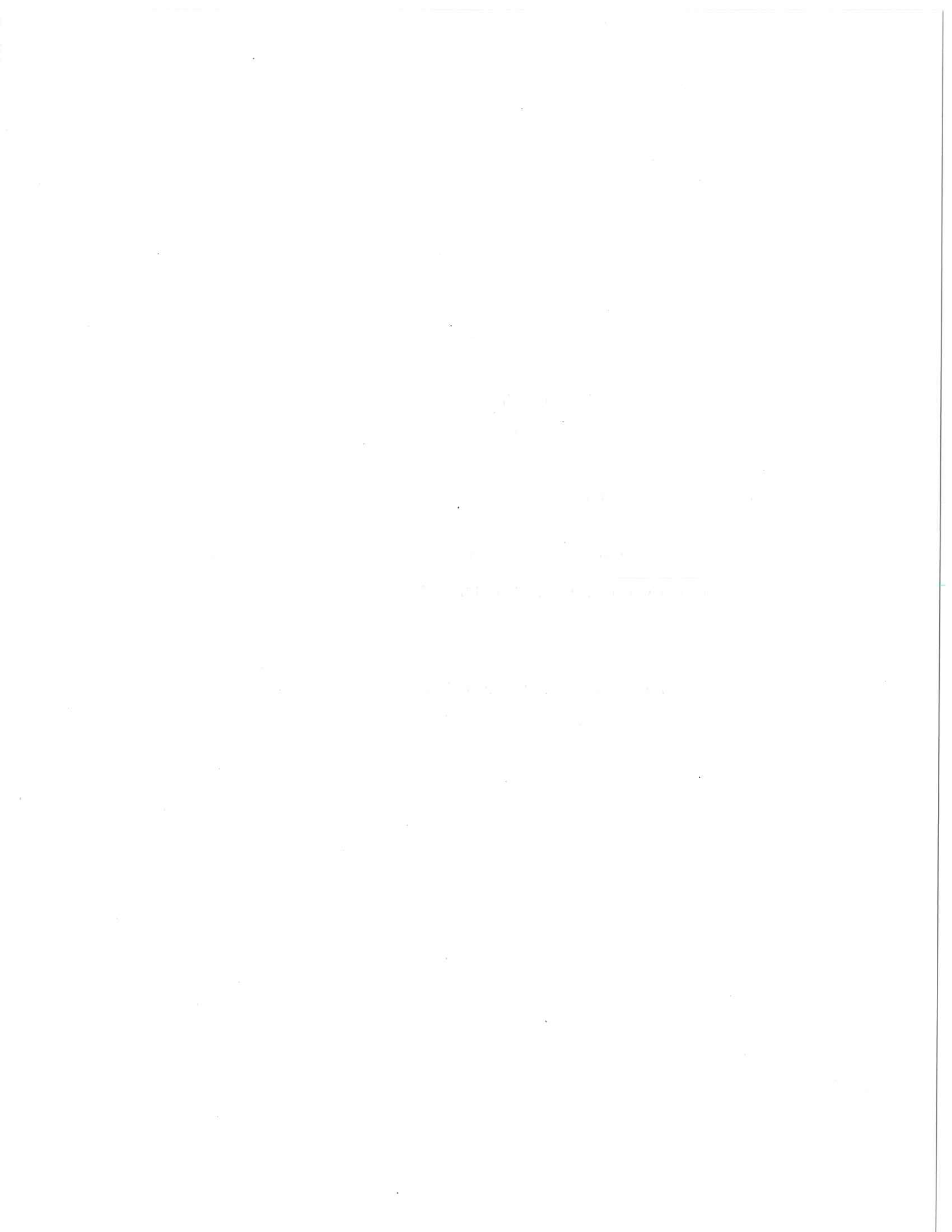
13 Members of the Howard County Board of Appeals shall be paid ~~[[\\$4,500.00]]~~

15 cumulative total payment of ~~[[\\$12,900.00]]~~ **\\$16,125** per year. Members of the Board shall  
16 receive reasonable and necessary expenses, as may be provided in the budget.
