9 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this subtitle is held invalid
10 by any court of competent jurisdiction, that portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and
11 independent provision; and the invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of
12 the subtitle and for this purpose, the provisions of this Act are declared severable.

Be it further enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that in accordance 15 with Section 22.1000 of the Code, the Department of Planning and Zoning shall submit an initial report on the analysis required under this Act, to cover the period from enactment of Council Bill62-16 17 2019 to 18 months after enactment of this Act, no later than 21 months after the enactment of this Act. The first three-year report, pursuant to Section 16.1219(b)(2) of this Act, shall be due by March 31, 18 19 2026. Thereafter, in accordance with Section 22.1000 of the Code, the Department of Planning and 20 Zoning shall report on the analysis required under this Act on or before March 31 following the 21 reporting period.

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23 Section 3. Be it further enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland, that this Act shall
 24 become effective 61 days after its enactment.
