1 **WHEREAS**, the Maryland Transit Administration is the designated recipient in
2 Maryland for grants under the Federal Transit Act; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the Administrator of the Maryland Transit Administration of the
5 Maryland Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants to counties and to
6 local governments for a mass transportation program of projects; and

7
8 **WHEREAS**, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations
9 upon the County, including the provision by the County of the local share of the project
10 costs in the program; and

11
12 **WHEREAS**, the County will file an application for Operational and Capital
13 funding assistance with the MTA for some or all of the following grants under the
14 Federal Transit Act: Metropolitan & Statewide Planning grants (Sections 5303, 5304 and
15 5305); Urbanized Area Formula Program grants (Section 5307/Large Urban); Bus and
16 Bus Facilities grants (Section 5309 and 5318); Formula Grants for Other than Urbanized
17 Areas grants (Section 5311); Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Funding Program
18 and the State Special Transportation Assistance Program (SSTAP); and

20 **WHEREAS**, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act
21 of 1964, it is required by the United States Department of Transportation that, in
22 connection with the filing of an application for assistance under the Federal Transit Act,
23 the applicant give an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of
24 1964 and the United States Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; and

26 **WHEREAS**, the County's goal is that minority business enterprise be utilized to
27 the fullest extent possible in connection with these projects and programs, and definite
28 procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that minority business shall
29 have the maximum construction contracts, supplies, equipment contracts or consultants
30 and other services.

1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the County Council of Howard
2 County, Maryland this 5th day of March, 2014 that the County's application
3 for a grant under the Federal Transit Act be endorsed.

5 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the County Council of Howard
6 County, Maryland that the County Executive is hereby requested to endorse this
7 resolution, thereby indicating approval thereof.

10 County, Maryland that copies of the Resolution be sent to the Maryland Transit
11 Administration of the Maryland Department of Transportation.
