WHEREAS, the Maryland Transit Administration is the designated recipient in 1 Maryland for grants under the Federal Transit Act; and 2 3 WHEREAS, the Administrator of the Maryland Transit Administration of the 4 Maryland Department of Transportation is authorized to make grants to counties and to 5 local governments for a mass transportation program of projects; and 6 7 WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations 8 upon the County, including the provision by the County of the local share of the project 9 10 costs in the program; and 11 WHEREAS, the County will file an application for Operational and Capital 12 13 funding assistance with the MTA for some or all of the following grants under the Federal Transit Act: Metropolitan & Statewide Planning grants (Sections 5303, 5304 and 14 5305); Urbanized Area Formula Program grants (Section 5307/Large Urban); Bus and 15 Bus Facilities grants (Section 5309 and 5318); Formula Grants for Other than Urbanized 16 17 Areas grants (Section 5311); Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Funding Program and the State Special Transportation Assistance Program (SSTAP); and 18 19 WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act 20 of 1964, it is required by the United States Department of Transportation that, in 21 22 connection with the filing of an application for assistance under the Federal Transit Act, the applicant give an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 23 1964 and the United States Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; and 24 25 WHEREAS, the County's goal is that minority business enterprise be utilized to 26 the fullest extent possible in connection with these projects and programs, and definite 27 procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that minority business shall 28 have the maximum construction contracts, supplies, equipment contracts or consultants 29 30 and other services.
