1 **WHEREAS**, Section 610 of the Howard County Charter authorizes and empowers
2 the Howard County Council to make supplementary appropriations from the unexpended
3 and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the County budget; and

5 **WHEREAS**, on May 26, 2021, the County Council passed Council Bill No. 34-
6 2021 that adopted the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Fiscal Year 2022;

9 **WHEREAS**, during the budget process, funding for the Body Worn Camera
10 Program was placed in the Contingency Reserve Fund pending further discussion of the
11 Program; and

13 **WHEREAS**, several subsequent meetings were held in which representatives of
14 the Department of Police, the Office of the State’s Attorney and the Sherriff’s Office
15 attended and answered questions about the Program’s operation; and

17 **WHEREAS**, funding for the Body Worn Camera Program can now be transferred
18 from the Contingency Reserve Fund to the Department of Police, Office of the State’s
19 Attorney and the Sherriff’s Office; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the Director of Finance has certified that the appropriation to be
22 transferred is not encumbered and is available for transfer.
