12	(a)	General Provisions. General provisions applicable to this Board are set forth in subtitle 3,	
13		"Boards and Commissions," of title 6, "County Executive and the Executive Branch," of the	
14		Howard County Code.	
15	(b)	Number of Members. The Planning Board shall have five members.	
16	(c)	Qualifications. (1) All members of the Planning Board shall be residents of Howard	
17		County.	
18		(2) EACH MEMBER SHALL RESIDE IN A DIFFERENT COUNCILMANIC DISTRICT.	
19		(3) AT LEAST ONE MEMBER SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF THE RURAL CONSERVATION DISTRICT	
20	OR 7	THE RURAL RESERVATION DISTRICT.	
21		(4) Each member shall complete the State of Maryland Planning Commission

(e) *Meetings*. The Planning Board shall hold regular monthly meetings. Special meetings may
 be held at any time, at the call of the Chair.

3 (f) *Records*. The Planning Board shall keep a record of its findings, recommendations,
4 determinations and decisions. The Planning Board shall keep minutes of its proceedings.
5 The records shall be filed with the Department of Planning and Zoning, which shall
6 maintain them.

7 (g) *Outside Assistance*. With the approval of the County Executive, the Planning Board may
8 retain legal counsel or consultants as necessary to carry out its function and duties and
9 responsibilities.

(h) *Studies*. The Planning Board may initiate studies related to the general duties and
responsibilities and functions of the Board. For the purpose of conducting such studies, the
Board shall have the assistance of the staff of the Department of Planning and Zoning, as
may be provided in the budget.

- (i) *Hearings*. Prior to making recommendations to the County Council on adoption of the 14 15 general plan, the Planning Board shall hold at least one public hearing at which interested persons shall be afforded a reasonable opportunity to be heard regarding the general plan. In 16 addition, prior to making recommendations to the County Council on adoption of 17 comprehensive zoning, the Planning Board shall hold at least one public hearing at which 18 19 interested persons shall be afforded a reasonable opportunity to be heard regarding the comprehensive zoning. In both cases, at least 30 days' notice of the time and place of the 20 21 hearing shall be on the County's website. The Planning Board may hold hearings on any 22 matter pending before it and shall hold hearings upon written request of the County 23 Executive or on resolution of the County Council and as required by law and regulations.

2		(i) <i>Recommendations</i> . Each year the Planning Board shall review the proposed	
3		capital program and any new or substantially changed capital project, pursuant to	
4		law. It shall prepare comments and recommendations on the impact of the	
5		proposed capital program on the County general plan and the growth of the	
6		County and submit these comments and recommendations to the County	
7		Executive, with a copy to the County Council.
