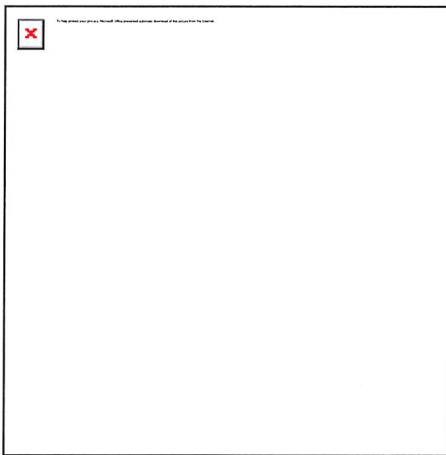

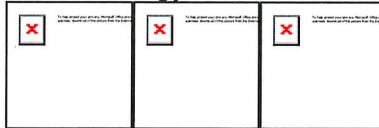

I wholeheartedly support CR29 and the development of Patuxent Commons!

My name is Janet Grove and I am a long-standing member of the Howard County Autism Society. I am a resident of Anne Arundel County and joined the Howard County Autism Society because no such organization exists in Anne Arundel County.

I have been a member of the HCAS Housing Committee for 10 years. I understand the dire need for housing for disabled individuals in general, and developmentally disabled individuals specifically. My son, who is 32, has Autism, Epilepsy, ADHD, Executive Functioning Disorder, and Nonverbal Learning Disorder. I have tried to transition Jeff to independent living with supports, because I had no other option and Jeff has no other family member to help him except me. Sadly, that effort has failed because Jeff has been unable to take his anti-seizure medications as prescribed and has not been able to maintain a healthy living environment. As a result, Jeff had a series of 2 seizures 2 months ago and sustained a serious injury to his right shoulder. His arm has been immobilized ever since and recovery will take 6 months.

If Jeff had had access to a residential option like Patuxent Commons, I am certain this injury would not have occurred. Patuxent Commons allows for disabled individuals to get the structure and support they need within the mutually supportive intergenerational community that the model offers. Patuxent Commons would serve more than just the disabled community, but also the elderly and some lower income families. It is a win-win!

Please be a part of history tonight and vote in favor of CR29! Patuxent Commons and Howard County can be the trailblazer for similar efforts in other Maryland counties and across the United States.
