1           **WHEREAS**, Section 907 of the Howard County Charter requires the County Council of  
2 Howard County to establish a Citizens’ Election Fund Commission consisting of five County  
3 residents appointed by the Council and two County residents appointed by the County Executive;  
4 and

6           **WHEREAS**, Section 10.310 of the County Code creates the Commission and provides for  
7 the qualifications, terms, and officers of the Commission; and

8           **WHEREAS**, the Commission’s purpose is to calculate, not later than 180 days prior to the  
9 end of the fiscal year, the total amount estimated for the full election cycle and the amount to be  
10 included in the current expense budget for the ensuing fiscal year to fully fund the Citizens’  
11 Election Fund System; and

13           **WHEREAS**, Section 10.310 of the County Code further requires that each nominee shall  
14 be confirmed by a separate Resolution of the County Council; and

15           **WHEREAS**, there is now a vacancy on the Commission and the County Council wishes  
16 to fill that vacancy.

18           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the County Council of Howard County,  
19 Maryland this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2022 that the representative of District 4 on the  
20 Citizens’ Election Fund Commission is Nadine Bernard, Laurel, MD. to serve a term beginning  
21 upon passage of this resolution and ending on May 1, 2025.
